SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Please submit all required documents by *February 1, 2012*.

Purpose: To a scholarship to a deserving African Native American student.

Criteria:

- Applicant must be a Freedmen descendant.
- Applicants must submit their ancestors roll number and document (s) tying the applicant to the Dawes enrollee Freedmen.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award or a returning college student.
- Applicant must demonstrate a positive impact or involvement in the community through letters of recommendation.

****NOTE****

Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited institution.

The following information must be submitted with this application. It will not be accepted separately.

- Submit three (3) letters of recommendation from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and community involvement.
- Attach a copy of a certified transcript of all high school or college courses taken to date, whichever transcript is most current (photocopy of official transcripts is acceptable).
- Attach a copy of your current class schedule, if you are attending high school or college.
- Attach a copy of the letter of acceptance from the college or university you will attend, or a statement explaining your acceptance.

Nations. Suggested prominent Freedmen would include but not limited to the following: Silas Jefferson, James Coody Johnson, Legus Perryman, Harry Island, Cow Tom, Charles Cohee, Stick Ross, Abraham, Buck Franklin or Dosar Barkus.

Describe your educational goals and accomplishments, both short-term and long-term, and proposed academic major.

Describe your past and current extracurricular activities, including community service, and other involvement.

Describe your career interest.

In a brief statement, add any additional information that you would like the committee to know in considering your application.
